Hastings Co-op grants helping to build 'a brighter future'

The hopes and dreams of 10 local community groups can now become a reality thanks to a \$16,000 funding injection from Hastings Co-op's Community Chest grants program.

This year's grants will fund everything from a defibrillator for Wauchope Walking Group and solar lighting for Wauchope Girl Guides' camp shed to building extensions for Wauchope Men's Shed and the replacement of Wauchope Cricket Club's flood damaged equipment.

Other projects include first aid kit upgrades for Wauchope Blues Junior Rugby League, a BBQ and removable tables and chairs for Wauchope Little Athletics, a portable PA system for Wauchope Swimming Club, specialised coaching for Wauchope Netball Club coaches, site upgrades for equestrian events at Rollands Plains Recreation Reserve and a freezer and ice maker for Wauchope Lions Club.

"This year's recipients were all looking for ways to improve, for the benefit of their members, and we're really pleased we could provide a helping hand," chief executive officer Allan said.

"The projects are far-reaching and will benefit a wide cross section of the community, and we hope each of the groups, their members, volunteers and the wider community enjoy the benefits of these grants for many years to come."

Mr Gordon explained that Hastings Co-op IGA customers play a vital role in the Community Chest program, with funds from specially-marked products, including the Community Co. range, pooled to provide the grants.

The \$16,000 in grants was also boosted by the sale of Hastings Co-op Cookies, which can be found at store checkouts.

"Every time customers purchase one of these specially-marked products they can feel good about giving back to the community too," he said.

"What's great about the Community Chest grants program is the projects are helping to build a brighter future, and more importantly, recognising the hard-working community groups that make a real difference to the local way of life, whether that's sports clubs, schools, volunteer organisations or disabiltiy and special interest groups.
